WORSHIP MINISTRIES

- Worship Ministries ensure Sunday services.
- * The Altar Guild provides set up & clean up for Communion elements, candles, frontals, linens, and other items during any service that takes place in the church. The Altar Guild also cares for the church's vestments.
- * The Flower Guild procures and arranges flowers for the High Altar in the Nave for Sunday services as well as feast and fast days.
- * Parish verger assists clergy before and during a service so clergy can attend to pastoral and liturgical concerns. At the clergy's behest, the verger assists in helping plan large services and coordinate those serving in those services.
- ➤ Eucharistic Ministers & Lay Readers enrich and support the service during eucharist and the readings. During our Zoom services, frequently children have been the readers.
- **★ Acolytes** made up of the children assist primarily during the 10am Sunday service.
- Bread Bakers bake the bread for eucharist each week.

PRESCHOOL

The CCEP preschool takes seriously the responsibility to develop children's minds, while not distancing God from academics. Children are given the opportunity to express themselves through art, music, language and dance. They learn to cooperate and work as a team. The highlight of the week is chapel on Wednesday morning with Miss Susie. The school's enrollment is doing well. There are five teachers/staff.
