


OUR CAMPAIGN GOAL FOR 2024 IS \$540,000.

Your pledge is carefully, prayerfully, and lovingly invested in our parish. From music, to fellowship, to building upkeep, and more, each dollar has its purpose and plan. To give a fuller picture of our expenses and how money is spent, we've put together the following narrative budget.

Even as we are challenged to discover what it means to be church, we are faithful to God, to each other and to the parish.

Here are some examples what we can accomplish when we come together:

If 50 people gave:

\$1 per month that would cover coffee

\$2 per month that would cover Sunday worship and altar supplies

\$9 per month that would cover Realm Church Management Software

\$10 per month that would cover instrumentalists and soloists

\$11 per month that would cover landscaping

\$12 per month that would cover family ministries supplies (not staff)

\$18 per month that would cover digital communications

\$24 per month that would cover janitorial services

\$104 per month that would cover utilities

If 150 people gave \$300 per month, we would achieve the campaign goal of \$540,000!

Children of all ages are welcome at Christ Church!

We are back in our classrooms for Sunday School and bringing our events back to in-person experiences!

Our younger kids (preschool through grade 5 are gathering together every Sunday morning to "Grow in Grace and Gratitude." Their eyes are bright when they arrive, and their hearts are full when they leave. Middle and High School kids are joining together each Sunday for "The Sacred Donut" where they share their week past and week ahead and noticing where God is in their daily lives. Our Nursery is going strong and staffed by a new supervisor who partners with teenagers to care for the littlest members of the parish every Sunday.

Throughout the year, we offer a wonderful array of special activities and events for children, youth, and adults!

Our comprehensive **Adult Christian Formation** includes forums, discussion groups, Bible studies, and more. Together, we explore theology, spirituality, the impact of the arts and literature on our lives, and practical ways to live out our Baptismal Covenant.

For deeper exploration, groups like **Education for Ministry (EfM), Women in Spirituality, Age-ing and Sage-ing, Spiritual Journey,** and **Centering Prayer** offer opportunities to study, reflect, and grow.

Pastoral care is our highest priority.

The pastoral care committee group provides the parish with care, support and understanding. Our members give a helping hand in an emergency, running errands, touching base via email or phone or with a visit, providing a hot meal, sending an encouraging card.

Eucharistic Visitors bring communion to those unable to be with us in person.

Christ Church Prayer Group is a small, group committed to pray by name for whomever prayer has been requested.

Fellowship is central to Christ Church. On the first Sunday of each month, we celebrate the Emmaus Meal. This is a simple potluck open to all.

We also have special receptions, parish picnics and various potlucks. Some include:

- Last Sunday after Epiphany Mardi Gras Brunch
- Easter Vigil Reception

These provide opportunities to meet Christ in our midst.

Stewardship 3%
